

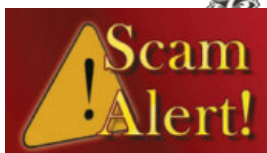

Germantown Senior Center Van Rides **Monday—Friday Van Service Information:**

(Reservations are only taken Monday -Friday...no calls accepted Sat or Sun)

- **Van operates Monday 9-1 Tuesday through Friday 9 am-2:30 pm**
- **Must call 24 hours in advance to book a ride (weekdays only)** , phone calls need to be received between 8 am and 4:15 pm the day before the ride you desire. 262.253.7799
- **Must reside in the village for ride pick up**
- When you make a reservation, please have the address of where you are going, where you are being picked up and your phone number.
- You are charged according to the mileage involved in the trip there and back
- We try to get as close to your desired time as possible, please be on time as we book many rides a day.
- Must be 55 years of age or older to use this service.
- Driver's cannot enter passengers home, a rider must be able to get out to the van on their own or have a caregiver with them.
- We cannot transport people home from the hospital or ER after a procedure.
- We also cannot transport large items in the van such as furniture, televisions etc.
- we cannot transport assisted living or memory care residents
- We cannot transport persons who are inebriated.

If the Center is Closed due to weather or a holiday, there is no van service.

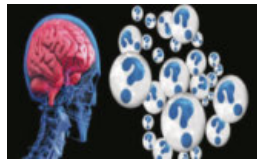
Dementia Screening

providing an opportunity for county residents to receive FRR memory screens to help raise awareness and provide an opportunity to begin a discussion about planning for the future. What is a memory screen? It is a wellness tool that helps identify possible changes in memory and cognition. Why have a screening done? It creates a baseline of where a person is at so any future changes can be monitored. Some Types of dementia are reversible with proper treatment. Dementias that are not reversible can be treated with medications that may slow the process and preserve quality of life for longer period of time. 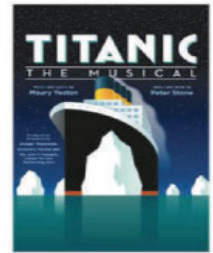
Fireside “Titanic”

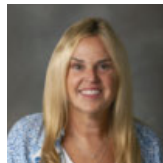


Hearing Help is now available at the Germantown Senior Center

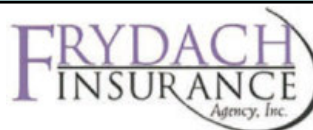

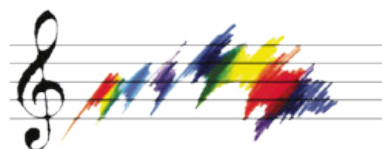
