ENERGY SERVICE BENEFITS



GETTING HELP WITH YOUR UTILITIES













We understand that there are moments in life where you can use a little help. As a certified partner of the Community and Economic Development Association of Cook County (CEDA), Oak Park Township can assist qualifying residents with their gas, electric, and other bills by applying

for current available energy benefits.

Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

This program is available to income-qualifying households and can assist households on their gas and electric bills by paying an amount of the utility company through a Direct Vendor Payment (DVP). This program is available from October 1st, 2024, to August 15th 2025 or until funds are exhausted.

Emergency Furnace

This benefit is available to LIHEAP-eligible homeowners whose heating systems are not operational or have been determined unsafe by their utility company or HVAC company.

Weatherization Program

This benefit helps eligible homeowners and renters reduce their heating and cooling bills by sealing cracks, adding insulation, checking drafts, and doing a furnace safety check to make the home more energy efficient.

Energy Efficiency Kits

CEDA's Energy Services provides two kits to eligible customers: ComEd I.E. Kits and Nicor Energy Efficiency Kits. These kits come with a wide variety of resources to make your home more energy efficient.

Additional Benefit Information

Currently, the PIPP and ComEd Hardship benefits are currently unavailable.

Please be sure to have the following documentation on hand for your appointment:

- Proof of 30-day income for all household members age 18 and older.
- Social Security Numbers for all household members. Undocumented individuals may also apply using their ITIN. If you do not have an SSN or ITIN, you are still eligible to apply.
- · Your most recent gas/electric utility bills.
- Proof of wages (including cash), unemployment, General Assistance, TANF, Social Security benefits, AABD, child support/alimony, self-employment, rental income, and/or Veteran assistance.



EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE





HELP WITH EXPENSES AND BILLS



Sudden financial hardship can be incredibly stressful on a family or individual when you can't pay living expenses such as rent, mortgage, utilities, and others. At these times, **Oak Park and River Forest residents can apply for Emergency Assistance** – a one-time financial benefit to help cover a cost that solves challenges such as potential eviction or utility shutdown.

How It Works

If you do not qualify for General Assistance, you are invited to apply for Emergency Assistance – a needs-based service that offers financial assistance for unpaid bills and expenses that alleviate a health and safety issue such as disconnected utility, or a work-related expense, to obtain or maintain employment, such as a car repair. The Emergency Assistance Program can help with the following bills and expenses:

- Job-related expenses such as transportation, work boots, uniforms
- · Rent, mortgage, and security deposits
- · Utilities such as gas, electric, Wi-Fi, and cell phone bills
- · Appliances such as washer, dryer, refrigerator, stove, water heater
- · Repairs, including car repairs and/or minor home repairs
- Handyman services
- Medical bills and medicine, or medical equipment not covered by health insurance
- · Dentures and/or Eyeglasses
- Storage and/or Moving fees (truck or packing company)
- · Pest Extermination, including bed bugs

Assistance is available <u>one time per household</u> within a program year (April 1-March 31). To apply, you must have less than \$5,000 in cash on hand or in a bank account. The program can assist up to \$1,600. If the request is greater than \$1,600 the client is responsible for paying the difference before being approved.

Checks are made payable through the Emergency Assistance program to the business owed by an applicant for a bill or expense. The Township will mail checks directly to the vendors, and it can take up to 2 weeks to receive.

Restrictions Due to Other Assistance

If you are already receiving or have applied for General Assistance, SSI (Social Security Income), or TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families), you cannot apply for Emergency Assistance. However, you can contact Oak Park Township for other financial assistance resources and referrals that may be available at (708) 383-8005.

If you need financial assistance:

- Contact the Oak Park Township at (708) 383-8005 to determine eligibility.
- A caseworker will call you and schedule an appointment, if you qualify. Walk-ins are not accepted.
- Please have all documentation required for the appointment ready and available for the caseworker. (See reverse side.)
- Financial assistance is based on household needs and funds available at the time of application. Emergency Assistance is available one time per household per program year.
- You must have a valid recent hardship and provide proof of the hardship that occurred within the last 90 days to qualify.

REDUCE DEPRESSION AND FEEL BETTER









The Program to Encourage Active, Rewarding Lives (**PEARLS**) is a free program available to older adults age 60+ living in Oak Park or River Forest who are encountering different kinds of depression.

This program is designed to reduce depressive symptoms in older adults through confidential, high-quality wellness care. Over a six-month period, including 6-8 sessions total held at home, phone, or virtually, a coach works directly with the participant to explore pathways to improved quality of life by focusing on personal goals, increased social and physical activities, problem-solving skills, and more.
