Lunch Service

Effective January 1, 2025 we will no longer be able to deliver lunches to house-bound seniors due to budget cuts. If you have a need for delivered meals, please contact Lutheran Community Services NW at 206-901-1685 or Catholic Community Services at 206-328-5696.

We have 2 types of lunch service, "To-Go" service which begins at 11:30 (you must come inside to pick up your meals) and "Dine-in" service which begins at 12:00pm. 

News from our Gardener

A New Year to learn some Latin

Let's start our new year learning different aspects of being a gardener. You see all of those different plants on the commercial nursery or department store tables but how do you tell if that is that beautiful plant that you're so sure will make your garden shine. The answer would be know the horticulture language of Latin. We see that language every time you pull out a dollar bill "Annuit Coeptis" could be a secret society code or it could just be a Latin phrase that was taken from a popular book our forefathers would have been reading which means, "He approves of the undertaking". Below the eye; "Novus ordo seclorum" a Q phrase or is it just Latin for a phrase this new country would like as "New order for the ages". My point being that when you use a dead language no one can change the wording to make the meaning different than its intent. Read this article written by Cindy Haynes from the lowa State University department of agriculture, to explain one of the frustrating aspects for new gardeners, being the use of Latin in scientific or botanical plant names. Believe it or not, botanical names were created by Carl von Linne to make plant names easier. Before Linne created the system, each plant had several names.

The first part of the binomial system is the Genus (always capitalized). The second part is the specific epithet (always lowercase). Together, the genus and specific epithet make up a species or name of a plant. This system is similar to an individual's name. Our last name identifies us to a particular group (family) like Antkowiak, or Jones. The Genera (plural for Genus) of Acer, Quercus, and Salvia do the same for plants. Our first name identifies us specifically as Audrey or Shari as do the specific epithets rubrum, alba, or splendens for plants. Put these two words together and you have the name of a specific individual (Jones Shari or Antkowiak Audrey) or plant species (Acer rubrum, Quercus alba, or Salvia splendens). The order of placement is the only difference between the two naming systems. The species names for plants are usually italicized or underlined. However, plants take it one step farther with the addition of the cultivar, or cultivated variety. Garden salvia or Salvia splendens is available in many colors. 'Salsa Scarlet' is a red-flowered cultivar while 'Salsa White' is a white-flowered cultivar. Cultivar names are usually in quotation marks and follow the specific epithet (Salvia splendens 'Salsa White').

So when you go to the local garden center and ask for red maple you could get any one of over several hundred different types of trees. But, if you ask for Acer rubrum 'Red Sunset', you are selecting a truly superior maple with brilliant red fall color. You can also be assured that Acer rubrum 'Red Sunset' is the same plant in Iowa, Louisiana, Great Britain, or anywhere else in the world. Otherwise what are you going to get for a red maple in Louisiana!

The genus name is usually a noun. Acer is a maple, Mentha is a mint, etc. The species name is commonly an adjective describing that member of the genus. The species name can tell you the color of the flower (rubra means red), where it originates (japonica means Japan), its form or habit (pendula means weeping), etc. Sometimes the combination of two Latin words make-up a specific epithet

a large flowering Magnolia.

The meaning of some common Latin words can help you know more about your plants. Basically the color, origin, form and habit of the plant. Know that master gardeners might not know every Latin phrase but we do know how to look them up. If you have a gardening question contact your local master gardener at pierce.mg@wsu.edu!




