

News from our Gardener

We all see these new homes, more like dwellings, that are being built in every nook and cranny space that is left open in Bonney Lake. Small is too big of a word to describe these places, yet home to someone who just might need a garden to bring that little bit of solitude to your soul as the day goes on. Consultants and garden educators like the Pierce County Master Gardeners have taken up the challenge to design gardens and to educate the community on small footprint gardens. With small gardening in mind; here are a few of the basics you can follow to grow a successful garden in limited areas.

Location, location is finding the area that you have where at least 6 hours of full sun and access to water for high care plantings in containers. Veggies need plenty of care so having containers near your kitchen door or main pathways will make watering and other garden maintenance that much easier. Remember to make your planting beds narrow so that they can be easily reached across. Containers should be at least 3-4 gallon capacity with a minimum of 12" in depth. Large containers have more space for roots and holding capacity for water so fill the container full of good soil with additional mineral nutrients added. Use different containers and techniques to take advantage of the small space.

Vertical growing can be the answer for growing in a small space. This technique tends to be the best gardening practice for a lot of plant species while increasing the diversity of the plants that you grow. Vertical growing lets air circulate among the plants which helps control disease and pest problems. With a vertical garden think "trellis". Not only will a trellis be useful to support your plants but it will also create a visual interest for your garden. Build your trellis well as it will eventually be supporting a lot of weight on those days when the wind is blowing and the rain is falling hard. You can be creative or not fancy at all but build your trellis tall, maybe a foot higher than the plants ultimate height. Combinations of bamboo, string, wire fencing or any study pole will function to get your plants off the ground. Have fun, as the trellis will be hidden by the plants in a few short weeks. Next you will need to train your plants. Choose varieties that ripen or flower over a long period of time and look for plants that are known climbers.

You are looking for a great variety of plants so make it over to the Pierce County Master Gardeners plant sale the last weekend of April at the University Extension on Pioneer Way South in Puyallup. I also recommend seeing the rhododendron garden in Federal Way for a glimpse of how a professional garden makes the magic happen.






