<u>Topping</u>

1/2 cup sugar

1/3 cup all-purpose flour

1 tsp. ground cinnamon

1/4 cup cold butter

Prep: 30 min.

Bake: 50 min. + cooling

Makes: 2 loaves (16 pieces each)

3 cups-all purpose flour

2 tsp. baking soda

1 1/2 tsp. ground cinnamon

1 tsp. ground cloves

1tsp. Ground nutmeg

3/4 tsp. salt

1/4 tsp. ground allspice

4 large eggs, room temperature

2 1/4 cups sugar

1 can (15oz.) pumpkin

3/4 canola oil

2 cups chopped peeled tart apples

1 cup golden raisins

- 1. In large bowl, combine the first 7 ingredients. In another large bowl, whisk eggs, sugar pumpkin and oil. Stir into dry ingredients just until moistened. Fold in apples and raisins. Transfer to 2 greased 9X5-in. loaf pans.
- **2.**For topping, in small bowl, combine sugar, flour and cinnamon. Cut butter until mixture resembles course crumbs; sprinkle over each Loaf.
- **3.** Bake at 350 degrees for 50-60 minutes or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from the pans to wire racks.
