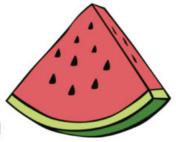

Russell has been fishing for over 60 years, mostly fresh water, some salt water. He has caught various local species such as carp, trout, bass, pickerel, flounder, bluefish, and stripers.

If you are looking for a local fishing spot, here are some of Russell's favorite places to go! In

Lynn, he enjoys fishing at Sluice Pond (pictured above), Flax Pond, Browns Pond, and around the Buchanan Bridge. The largest fish he ever caught, around 3ft long, was at Buchanan bridge! Other spots on the North Shore include, Wenham's Pleasant Pond, and the Breakheart Reservation in Saugus.

For fishing beginners, here's some advice from Russell! Look for stable conditions in the water, no rain or wind, no rushing water. Different baits and lures are required for different fish, you can talk with a friend to see what they like to use. Be prepared for the weather, bring sun protection, hat, sunscreen, sunglasses, bug spray and water. Fishing requires time and patience, He recommends bringing music, a book, cards to play with friends and snacks to pass the time. If fishing near the woods, wear high socks to protect from ticks. If you'd like to get fishing, don't forget your fishing license! You can purchase your license in person at Walmart in Lynn or online at MassFishHunt.

Russell's favorite things about fishing are enjoying nature, relaxing in the quiet, the comradery with other fishermen, the thrill of the hookset and catching fish! *Fish on*! If you have any questions about fishing or want to hear any of his exciting fishing stories he is at the Lynn Senior Center on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, and happy to help you!
