STANDING STRONG TOGETHER



Our Anshe Chesed Fairmount Temple community stands in solidarity with the people of Israel. In multiple communications with you since the Hamas terrorist attacks on Simchat Torah, we've shared how eager we are to bring aid to those whose lives were forever changed by the killings and kidnappings. We want to catalyze prayers for peace, healing to those injured, and advocacy to help Israel be strengthened in its defense.

Due to your generosity, we've begun to make allocations from **Fairmount Temple's Sholomon Adopt-Israeli-Families Fund, to support families in Israel of all backgrounds affected by the traumas of this war.** If you wish to be part of our synagogue's efforts, you may continue to send financial support in any amount to our Sholomon Adopt-Israeli-Families Fund, online via our website, or sending checks to our temple office.



We were proud on October 9 to join many of you among the 2,000 people at the Cleveland Stands with Israel Rally at the Jewish Federation of Cleveland. During this event, Cantor Vladimir Lapin sang, and many of us listened carefully to presentations by the Chair of the Federation Board Dan Zelman, Congresswoman Shontel Brown, and Rabbi Yael Dadoun of The Temple-Tifereth Israel, among others. On October 13, Rabbi Caruso shared a compelling sermon, *Grieving for Israel*, which is posted at fairmounttemple.org in the "Voices" link in the upper right corner.

We want you to know our temple has been hearing from young adults around the U.S. who grew up at Fairmount Temple, and are feeling isolated in discussions about the war between Israel and Hamas. We've organized Zoom calls to help them connect with us to consider their response to anti-Israel demonstrations, conflicting media reports, and their own rising concern for the consequences of war on Israelis and Palestinians. We are here at temple to be a steadying presence, and to help people of all ages connected to Fairmount Temple, to increase their knowledge and seek paths to respond to violence impeding Israel and the entire world from living in greater peace.

As we enter November, Fairmount Temple is engaged in multiple endeavors. In addition to our response to the war in Israel, temple volunteers are sending postcards to encourage all eligible voters to perform the mitzvah of voting on November 7, continuing an interfaith book discussion with members of Fairmount Presbyterian Church, supporting the Greater Cleveland Congregations in a new campaign to reduce medical debt, and teaching students in our early childhood program, and lower and upper religious school programs. On December 8 at Shabbat Chanukah, we'll bless the Consecration Class of 5784. All this is occurring while temple has convened town hall meetings and responded to congregants with ideas about a proposed future unification with The Temple-Tifereth Israel. There are also two upcoming sessions led by Wendy Jacobson, LISW, and Marcia Levine, ACWS, for us to gather insights as congregants process their feelings about the proposed unification. See page 5.

RECOVERING FROM THE FIRE

In many ways, the April fire seems distant. We've been gathering, learning, remembering, and praying since then in a lot of creative ways. We will always find a way forward together. With the context of our conversations with The Temple-Tifereth Israel, we're keeping in mind all of the possibilities in the coming months. That's why we're conservatively approaching the restoration process in the front of the building, with a focus on keeping temple clean, safe and dry, and also reopening some of the large spaces for us to gather this winter. Electrical work that powers our security systems and other elements that keep us safe and warm are nearly done - just in time for this cooler weather. Roof work will take place before winter settles in, to ensure our assets are protected. This will allow us to reopen the Bonda Chapel, Spiegle Sukenik Atrium Foyer, and Weinberg Social Hall later this winter. We'll keep you posted as the progress continues in upcoming *Connections* eblasts.

In the meantime, we've been celebrating and gathering successfully and creatively in and around our temple in the undamaged area (*Pictured above is a Women of FT gathering in the Gray Garden*), as well as our inspirational and beautiful High Holy Day services held at Severance Music Center!

OUTREACH TO COLLEGE STUDENTS

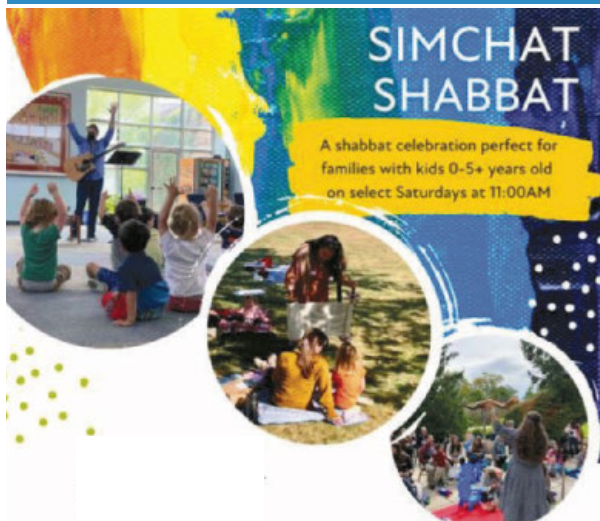

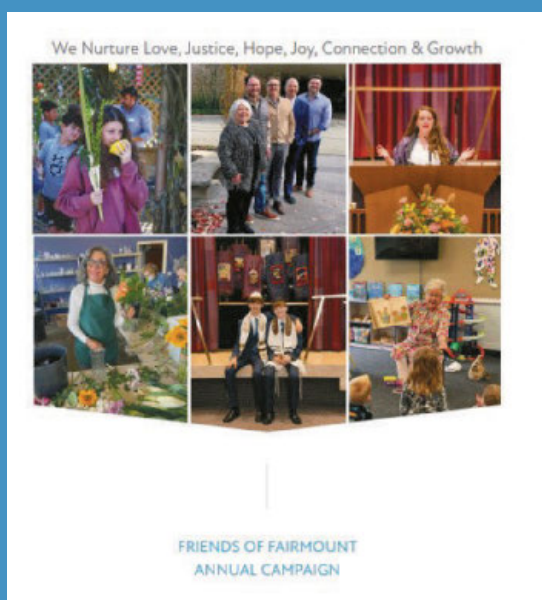

CIVIL RIGHTS HISTORIC TRIP WITH RABBI CARUSO AND CANTOR SAGER



Activism and Supporting Civil Rights have long been part of our Fairmount Temple History. Rabbi Arthur J. Lelyveld (Senior Rabbi, 1958-1986), was a social justice leader and was active in the Civil Rights movement of the 1960s. He participated in Freedom Summer, registering Black voters in the South. On one trip, he was beaten with a tire iron, an image captured by a photographer and shared world-wide.

In April, Cantor Laureate Sarah Sager and Rabbi Joshua Caruso will lead a **Civil Rights Historic trip** in and around Montgomery, Alabama. The trip will include a visit to Selma and an opportunity to walk across the Edmund Pettus Bridge, a visit to the Rosa Parks Museum, and The Legacy Museum in Montgomery, AL, which chronicles America's history of racial injustice.

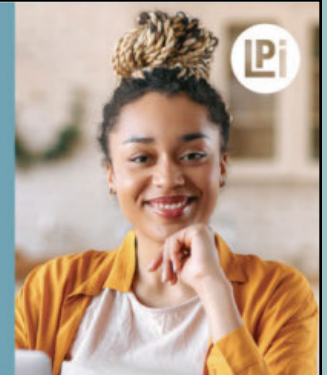
