

#### ATTENTION MARINES AND MARINE FAMILIES! THE CAMP LEJEUNE JUSTICE ACT IS NOW LAW!

If you or a family member lived, worked, or were exposed to the water at Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune between 1953 and 1987 and were later diagnosed with a serious illness or medical condition, you may be entitled to compensation for your personal injuries or your loved-one's wrongful death.

All personal injury or wrongful death lawsuits under the CLIA must be filed in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of North Carolina. These are North Carolina federal cases overseen by North Carolina federal judges and tried before North Carolina federal juries. Talk to an experienced Eastern North Carolina federal court lawyer today for free to discuss your case.

Wrongful death claims may be available under the CLJA even if your loved one passed long ago. Time is limited to bring a claim under the CLJA.
