Meals on Wheels - Pets

Meals on Wheels – Pets began in Davidson County in June of 2016 thanks to a grant provided by Meals on Wheels America. The program has served hundreds of animals thousands of pounds of pet food over the past 7 years.

For many Meals on Wheels clients who have a pet, their treasured companion is often a highlight of their life. Older adults can feel a sense of purpose in providing care and affection for a pet and receive unconditional love in return. Studies have shown that seniors with pets are almost 40% less likely to report loneliness and have 21% fewer doctor visits. While the benefits of companionship are clear, taking care of a pet can be financially and physically challenging for seniors. With inflation on the rise, many struggle to provide their pets with a steady supply of pet food. Some seniors may give or share their daily meal provided by Meals on Wheels with their pet which could lead to a risk of poor nutrition. Additionally, because seniors have limited mobility, they have difficulty traveling to and from the store for pet food.

The Meals on Wheels Davidson County Pet Program addresses these issues, and thus helps clients and their pets stay together. The Meals on Wheels Pets initiative is just another way that Meals on Wheels can deliver so much more than just a meal. To qualify you must receive Meals on Wheels from Davidson County Senior Services, pets must be companion animals, and the monthly household income must be at or under 100% of the current National Poverty Guidelines.

Davidson County Senior Services Transportation

Davidson County Senior Services provides transportation to residents who are age 60 and older. Transportation may be accommodated for medical appointments, general trips such as going to the grocery store or pharmacy or to one of four Cafes (congregate nutrition sites).

Senior Services Transportation includes options such as door-to-door and fixed or circular routes in and between Lexington and Thomasville. Circular city route brochures are available at both the Lexington and Thomasville Senior Services buildings.



Davidson County Senior Services receives grant funds that are currently used to pay for the Senior Transportation Program. These funds allow transportation services to be offered at no cost to the passenger, however, client contributions are encouraged.

Senior Services was recently awarded additional funding from the Administration for Community Living (ACL) as part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). This grant will provide support through Sept. 30, 2024 to accommodate trips to the four Cafes including an additional day to the Denton Cafe, as well as accommodating more out-of-county medical trips.

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Crafting and Encouraging Others Go Hand in Hand

The ladies in Davidson County Senior Center Lexington's Creative Creations share a passion for two things – crafting and helping others. Put those passions together and you get a bundle of handmade blankets, hats and scarves to benefit county residents fighting cancer.



Several members of the group also knit prayer shawls for anyone who needs encouragement through First Baptist Church. The crafters jumped at the opportunity to extend their ministry when Ray Howell, Executive Director of Cancer Services of Davidson County approached the group about contributing to their gift bags for cancer patients. They immediately begin knitting blankets, hats and scarves to include in the bags. This project had a special meaning for the ladies as they have lost two members of their group to cancer over the past few years. Lynn Mack and Marie Pressley were longtime participants of the Creative Creations and both left a lasting impact on the group.

"Marie didn't throw anything away. She made us save everything because we may find a good use for it someday," shared Mary Harrell. "She had the ultimate patience and would do anything to help someone," Harrell continued.
