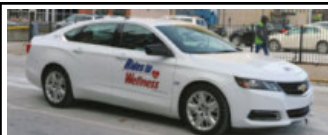
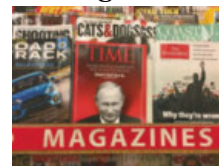


Our Library is **CLOSED** on Fridays
