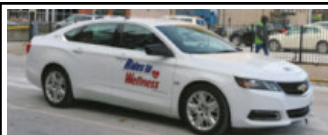
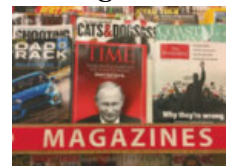


Our Library is CLOSED on Fridays between 1:30 to 4:00 pm & Friday, October 18th our Library is CLOSED all day!
