Say there is a **PROBLEM** or promise a prize. **PRESSURE** you to act immediately. Tell you to **PAY** in a specific way. **DO NOT** give scammers money or personal information—ignore them! **How to avoid a scam:** Remain calm. Talk to someone you trust. Hang up or ignore the message. **DO NOT** click on links or attachments. Protect your money. Criminals will insist that you pay in a hard-to-trace manner, such as with a gift card, prepaid debit card, cryptocurrency, wire transfer, money transfer, or by mailing cash.
