

Besides general Medicare and Medicaid questions and enrollment, MMAP Counselors may also help you with information and enrollment in the Medicare Savings Program.

Medicare Savings Program

Fridays - Call for an appointment You may be eligible for the Medicare Savings Program!

Do you want your \$174.70 put back into your social security check and still have Part B coverage?

Requirements (DHHS makes final determinations - this is not a guarantee):

- Are you on Medicare?
- Have an income at or below \$1,660 a month if single or less than \$2,239 a month if married.
- Are your savings, investments and real estate (other than your home and vehicle) less than \$8,400 if single or less than \$12,600 if married?

Make an appointment with our MMAP Counselors if you believe you qualify for this program by calling (810) 744-0960.

Medicare/Medicaid Open Enrollment

Ends December 7th

Open Enrollment is your time to review your Medicare health or drug coverage and decide if you want to make changes. Remember, Medicare costs and benefits can change each year. Comparing your options could help you find better coverage or save money.

During Open Enrollment, you can switch from Original Medicare to a Medicare Advantage Plan, change to another Medicare Advantage Plan, switch back to Original Medicare, or keep your current coverage.

If you've reviewed your options and you're happy with your current coverage, you don't need to do anything.

The Genesee County CARD Hot Lunch Program is served at 11:30 am Monday - Friday at the Burton Senior Center. Reservations must be made by **Noon** the day before you plan to have lunch. This is a donation based program. Requested donations are \$3.00 per meal, under 60 and non-Genesee County residents are \$6.00.

TEFAP Supplemental Food Program Must come inside senior center for this program

December 17th, (2:00 - 3:00 pm)

TEFAP is an additional supplemental commodity program that is distributed quarterly (March, June, September, December) on the regular commodity day. TEFAP has a higher income qualification. You may be eligible for this program if you don't qualify for the monthly commodities.

Income qualifications are:

Family of 1 - \$2,510/monthly or less Family of 2 - \$3,407/monthly or less

Commodity Supplemental Food Program Must come inside senior center for this program

December 17th, (2:00 - 3:00 pm)

The Commodity Supplemental Food Program provides a distribution of food once per month to those who need it. The box of food includes items such as cereal, juice, canned meats, canned fruits and vegetables, pasta, beans, oats and cheese. The items change each month.

The program qualifications are:

- 60 years or older & income of:
- Family of 1 \$1,632/monthly or less
- Family of 2 \$2,215/monthly or less

MiCAFE (Bridge Card Application)

Fridays 10:00 am - 2:00 pm (By Appointment)

The Michigan Coordinated Access to Food for the Elderly (MiCAFE) project makes it easier for seniors to get the food they need to live healthy lives through the Food Assistance Program. You may now apply for the Michigan Bridge Card at the Burton Senior Center and not have to go to the State Building to apply (or re-apply) for these benefits.
