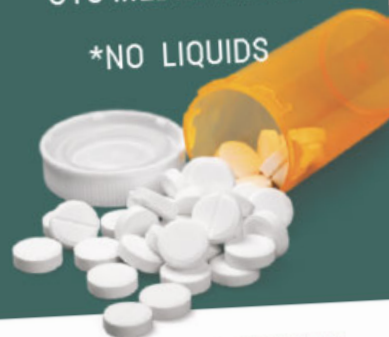

May is Older Americans Month

When Older Americans Month was established in 1963, only 17 million living Americans had reached their 65th birthday.

About 1/3 of older Americans lived in poverty and there were few programs to meet their needs. Interest in older Americans and their concerns was growing.

A meeting in April 1963 between President John F. Kennedy and members of the National Council of Senior Citizens led to designating May as 'Senior Citizens Month,' the prelude to 'Older Americans Month.'


Historically, Older Americans Month has been a time to acknowledge the contributions of past and current older persons to our country, in particular those who defended our country.

Every President since Kennedy has issued a formal proclamation during or before the month of May asking that the entire nation pay tribute in some way to older persons in their communities. Older Americans Month is celebrated across the country through ceremonies, events, fairs, and other such activities.

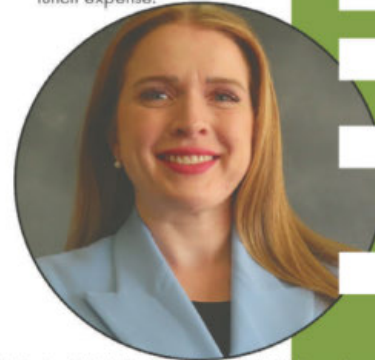

HOME DELIVERED MEAL PROGRAM

The Home Delivered Meals program provides five meals per week. These meals are delivered on three days per week: Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays. Three ready-to-eat meals are provided as well as two frozen meals per week.

Eligibility: Branch County seniors age 60+ who are **home-bound** qualify for this program. An initial assessment at the client's home must be scheduled and completed before participation in this program can begin.

This service is funded by state and federal grants as well as senior millage. There is a \$3 suggested donation per meal; however, a donation is not required.

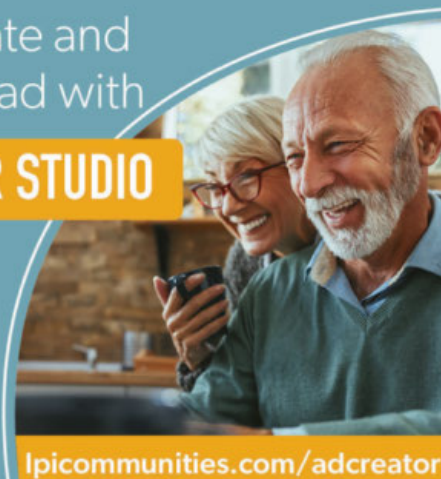
